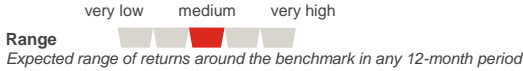
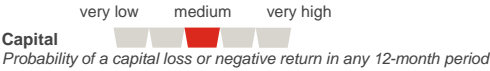

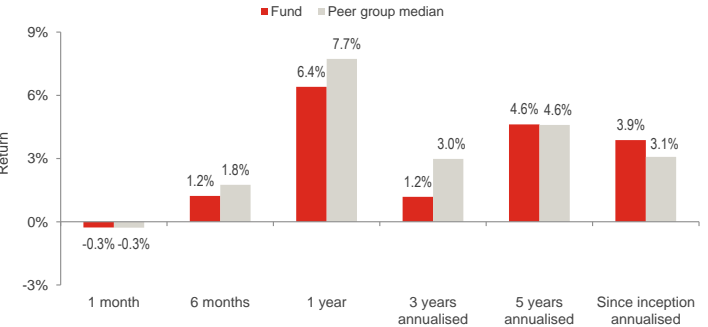

Investment objective

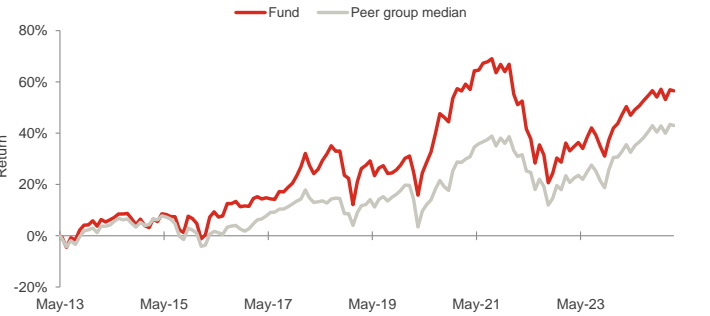
The primary objective of the Fund is capital appreciation in real terms over the investment horizon. The Fund is ideally suited to investors with a moderate to aggressive risk tolerance (measured in the base currency of the Fund) over an investment cycle of five years or longer. The diversified portfolio invests into a wide range of asset classes including cash, fixed income, equities, property and commodities. As this portfolio is global in nature, exposure will be taken in a wide range of currencies and markets.

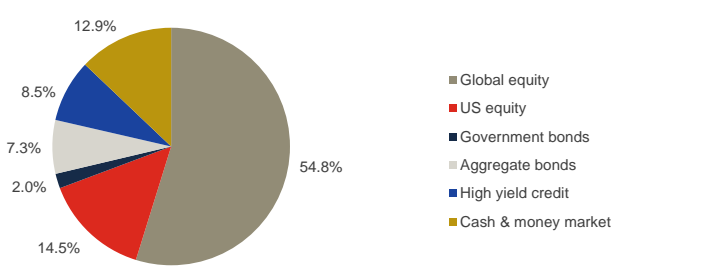

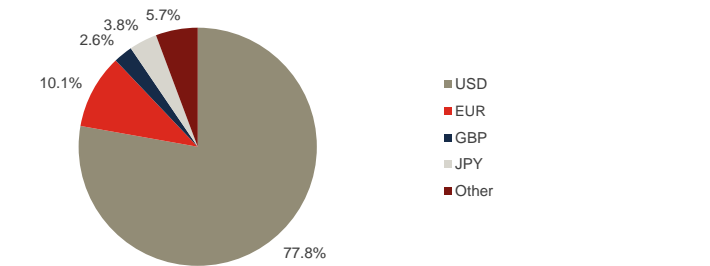

■ Market commentary

February was a tough month for the market as economic uncertainties grew and risk-off sentiment took over. Investors became more worried about the potential economic fallout from the Trump administration's policies. US consumer confidence dropped sharply, marking its largest decline since August 2021. Since stepping into office in January, Trump has unleashed a wave of tariffs and disruptive policy changes, keeping markets on edge. This pressured US equities as Trump's tariff push sparked uncertainty over potential trade wars and fears of global inflation.

The S&P 500 ended the month down 1.30%.

The UK market ended on a high note, with the FTSE 100 climbing 2.0% MoM (+7.8% YTD). However, January brought a surprise, with inflation jumping to 3.0% from 2.5% in December (the fastest rate since March 2024). Core inflation also picked up, rising to 3.7% from 3.2%, adding a bit of uncertainty to the otherwise positive momentum.

FTSE 100 TR finished the month 2.00% higher.

In the Eurozone, equities faced pressure after Trump announced plans for 25% tariffs on the European Union (EU). However, major European markets defied the headwinds, closing February with a tenth consecutive week of gains and outperforming the US. The MSCI Europe ex-UK Index rose 3.4%, driven by increasing hope for a ceasefire in Ukraine. European financials extended their strong run, surpassing US firms with remarkable returns on equity. Meanwhile, European defence stocks soared by 9.3%, as a renewed focus on domestic production boosted investor confidence.

Germany's elections saw Friedrich Merz emerge as the next chancellor after his centre-right Christian Democratic Union (CDU) and its sister party secured 28.6% of the vote. After the election, Merz emphasized the need for Europe to become more "independent" from the US, as Trump's policies continued to shake up US-Europe relations while leaning towards Russia.

Emerging market (EM) stocks delivered a shy gain in February, with the MSCI EM up 0.5% MoM. These gains were fuelled by solid gains from Chinese companies, especially those listed outside China. Stocks of Chinese firms in Hong Kong rose 14% MoM, while US-listed Chinese companies climbed 9% MoM. Ongoing enthusiasm for DeepSeek's potential kept momentum strong in the Chinese tech sector. Investor sentiment improved after President Xi Jinping met with key private sector leaders, suggesting a new focus on strengthening the private sector to revitalize China's economy.

Emerging Markets (MSCI EM 50 NR) ended the month up 3.60%.

The Caléo Global Flexible Fund ended the month down 0.27%.
