
Investment objective





Market commentary

On the surface, markets appear to have been uneventful in July, with few sizeable moves over the month. However this masked a significant shift in the underlying market narrative, in particular a more cautious view of the US economy that led to a setback in equity markets from mid-month and a more meaningful sell-off at the start of August. Wall Street fell 9% from its all-time high in mid-July to early August, with mega cap tech stocks coming under pressure, while defensive sectors such as consumer staples and healthcare held up better. The Bank of Japan raised interest rates for the second time this year, triggering a sharp rise in the yen and a dramatic one day sell-off in Japanese equities, that was partially reversed the next day

Bond markets saw significant moves as yields fell sharply. The moves were driven not so much by a flight to safety but more because market expectations of rate cuts by the Fed changed substantially, with a 50bps cut at the next meeting of the FOMC in September almost fully priced in, followed by two further cuts by year end. With inflation easing, markets believe the Fed's focus will increasingly shift to the employment part of its dual mandate, amidst signs of a weakening jobs market.

Developed markets, measured by the MSCI World index, returned +1.8% in July, with the US returning +1.2%. Emerging markets rose +0.3% in local terms. Bond markets returned +2.9% over the month, as measured by the ICE BofA Global Broad Market index, with US Treasuries returning +2.1%.

Markets have adjusted rapidly to the changed narrative; valuations of equities are now lower and while short term volatility could remain high as unwinding of extended positions might have further to run. systemic risks are minimal, corporate profits are generally holding up well, and the Fed's rate cutting cycle is about to begin. We are more cautious on bond markets at these lower yields, as markets appear to be discounting tougher economic conditions than seem likely. Events last month and at the start of August illustrate the vital importance of diversification, across asset classes, regions, and
